



WOMEN OF ASPHALT & SAPA Partnership Agreement

Asplialt Pavement Association (SAPA) is to provide a monally beneficial partnership that provides value to the industry by creating a community of support and advocating for women in the asplialt workforce. The mission of the World regularization is to load and insper women with the purpose of increased recruitment and returnium of women in the genhalt industry. SAPA zations and WofA will work together to support the mission by creating state WofA branches. Should a SAPA so desire, the transfers will be embedded into the organizations

Together, the SAPA and the Work will support utate branches through collaborative efforts as

- All events, outreach and mesonging of the WorlA state branch shall embody the mission vision and goals of national WorlA.
- 2. - The SAPA will have the financial responsibility of the state WolA brunch. If National WolA provides support money to the SAPA for WolA branch events, National WolA may request an annual report of activities and financial overview of how these funds are utilized to support branch outreach and events. The SAPA will ensure any fundraising efforts or nations collected specifically for the state WofA branch will be designated solely for that purpose. If required, the SAPA shall make advance payment and sign contract for a branch event.

This agreement is effective upon execution and will continue in full force until either partner gives written notice to the other party to terminate the Agreement.

MISSION: The mission of the Women of Asphalt PA Branch will be:


- 1. To foster and promote mentoring and networking opportunities for women in asphalt.
