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

  - TBD later this year








## eCAMMS – Upcoming Release 46 (Mar 2025)

#### eCAMMS – Aggregate Cert Caveat

- Only for aggregates approved and listed in Bulletin 14
- Certificates for materials that are approved through a 'rider' approval must still be created through DocuSign process
- Example If you are approved and listed in Bulletin 14 for coarse aggregate A57 and have a rider approval for No. 10 aggregate:
  - For shipments of A57, you can use eCAMMS to create CS-4171
  - For shipments of No. 10, you must use DocuSign to create CS-4171
    - Do NOT generate a cert for A57 to cover your No. 10 shipment. It will be rejected.



#### What Happens After Agg/Conc Cert Generated in eCAMMS

- Overnight batch process imports 4171 Certification PDFs into ECMS
- Contractor login to the ECMS project and click on Material Certifications






 From the dropdown, the Contractor selects which type of cert they are looking for:

• Then they click the *Add Certification* button



- The Contractor is presented a list of Suppliers and Material Classes
  - In the case of concrete, they also see Mix Design Numbers



 They click the green plus button in the row of the material they want to enter a certification for




 The Contractor is then presented a list of shipments matching the criteria they have selected



 Using the checkboxes, they select the records they want to add to the project and click the Save Selected button at the top



 The Contractor is returned to the list of Material Certifications and the items they selected have been added




The Contractor should do one last check by clicking on the certified date




#### Aggregate and Concrete Material Certifications – Final Thoughts



- For all 2025 asphalt JMF submissions, there is a requirement for EPD data entry
- Data entry is accomplished using the Add Reference Data button at the bottom of the JMF Design page
